

Texas District Financial Plan according to the Texas District Constitution

- 1. Ministerial Membership Dues
 - (a) All ministers shall contribute seventy-five percent (75%) of their ministerial tithing into the District treasury for the District operation and work. The District Secretary-Treasurer shall send ten percent (10%) of the seventy-five percent (75%) of ministerial tithing back to the sections for operational expenses. This rebate to the sections shall be calculated as follows: Five percent (5%) of the seventy-five percent (75%) of ministerial tithing shall be evenly divided among all sections. The other five percent (5%) of the seventy-five percent (75%) of ministerial tithing shall be sent back to the section from which it came. The District Secretary-Treasurer shall also send fifteen percent (15%) of the seventy-five percent (75%) of ministerial tithing to Texas Bible College.
 - (b) Every minister that is working and not paying ministerial tithes (according to Section 5.03, Paragraph 2a, listed above) into the District shall be required to send thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month to the District. This does not have to be tithes. Exceptions can be made when ministers are living on a pension or Social Security or under North American Missions status.
 - (c) Each full-time evangelist and Texas Bible College faculty member shall be permitted to register with the District Board, and upon their approval, the evangelist and faculty member shall contribute one hundred percent (100%) tithe into the District Treasury. The District Secretary-Treasurer shall be authorized by the District Board to refund fifty percent (50%) to the evangelist and faculty member approximately two (2) to four (4) weeks prior to the General Conference provided the evangelist or faculty member states his intention to attend said current conference. This rebate shall be used for the purpose of defraying actual Conference expense. The rebate will be computed on the amounts received after the date the eligible minister registers in writing with the District Secretary-Treasurer.
